40 hours a week, from Monday to Friday, from 8.00am to 4.00; 30 hours lessons plus 10 hours lunch and playtime.

Lessons take place from Monday to Saturday 8.00am-1pm.

Parents have to respect the school timetable of start and end of lessons.

The school diary of our Istituto Comprensivo has to be used to write any communication between school and family.

Absences, delays and early leavings have to be justified by parents or anyone responsible for the child through notes in the school diary.

For any required authorization (school visits, declaration of release, etc...), please visit the school website or ask teachers any information.

Missing periods longer than 5 days have to be justified by a medical certificate released by a pediatrician or a GP.

Parents of pre-primary and primary school children with special needs have to communicate any change of the canteen menu to ASSO (tel 071/7202154).

Medicines cannot be given to children except in authorized cases according to the due procedure. These cases need to be requested through a special form with, in attachment, the medical certificate.

In our school there is a desk for children with special needs where a teacher can provide information and help to families. There is also a counseling desk for psychological support devoted to both parents and children.

In every school order, children need specific didactic material: you can find it on the school website but, for any further information, you can contact the teachers directly.

For PE activity trainers, a second T-shirt and a towel are required.

For birthdays celebrated at school, food must be bought in shops and show ingredients labels. Homemade food is not allowed.

Digital devices (computers, I-pads, tablets, etc...) have to be used according to the school rules which are also reported in the school diary.

Students shouldn't bring any valuable objects to school because, in case they are lost or damaged, school staff won't be responsible for them.
